- منح إجراء أبحاث وجمع مادة علمية للطلبة المسجلين للحصول على درجة الدكتوراه بإحدى الجامعات المصرية.
- منح الإشراف المشترك للدكتوراه والتي توفر الفرصة لطلبة الدكتوراه بالجامعات المصرية لإجراء أبحاث وجمع مادة علمية والإشراف المشترك مع أستاذ أمريكي.

والجدير بالذكر أن المنح مموله بالكامل وتغطي كافة نفقات الإقامة والتأمين الصحي والسفر إلى ومن الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية بالإضافة إلى النفقات الدراسية المتعلقة بمنح درجة الماجستير.

**ثانياً برنامج زمالة هيوبرت همفري (Hubert H. Humphrey Fellowship Program):**

يوفر البرنامج فرص للدراسة واكتساب الخبرات الإدارية والقيادية، لمدة عام أكاديمي واحد، للمهنيين الذين لا تقل خبرتهم المهنية عن خمس سنوات من بعد الحصول على درجة البكالوريوس أو البكالوريوس والذين لديهم قدرات قيادية واهتمام بالخدمة العامة في بلادهم. وفي خلال فترة المنحة، يشارك الزملاء في برامج أكاديمية بالإضافة إلى أنشطة مهنية متعلقة بمجالات عملهم. هذا وسوف تقوم الهيئة بتغطية كافة مصاريف الجامعة والإقامة والتأمين الصحي خلال مدة المنحة بالإضافة إلى نفقات السفر إلى ومن الولايات المتحدة الأمريكية.

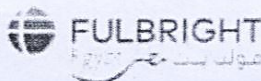

## AY2023-2024 Fulbright Egyptian Student Program Master's Degree Grant

The program provides fully funded master's degree grants for university graduates to study in the U.S. for a maximum of two years.

**All fields are eligible.**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

- Egyptian citizenship. U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are **not eligible** to apply.
- Applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Bachelor's degree:
  - Minimum of "Good" for applicants in the humanities and social sciences.
  - Minimum of "Very Good" for applicants in the sciences.
- Proof of English Language proficiency. Applicants must submit a valid score report for **only one** of the following tests:
  - TOEFL ITP - minimum required score of 550
  - TOEFL iBT - minimum required scores of 80
  - Academic or General IELTS - minimum overall score of 6.5
  - Duolingo English Test - minimum required score of 105
  - English Proficiency Test from Egyptian Universities - minimum required score of 550
- Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants must successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).

*Note: Preference will be given to applicants without prior significant experience in the U.S. and/or overseas.*

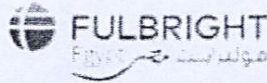

## AY2023-2024 Fulbright Egyptian Student Program Ph.D. Joint Supervision Grant

The program provides fully funded grants for students registered in Ph.D. programs at universities in Egypt to collect data and/or conduct research for their Ph.D. degrees under the joint supervision between a supervisor in Egypt and an American co-supervisor in the U.S. Candidates selected under this program spend up to one academic year at an American university to conduct doctoral dissertation research under the supervision of their American co-supervisor. US co-supervisors for selected candidates attend the student's Ph.D. thesis defense in Egypt (within two years following return of the student).

**All fields are eligible.**

### **Eligibility Criteria:**

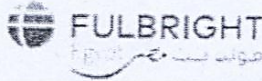
- Egyptian citizenship. U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are **not eligible** to apply.
- Applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Applicants must have a strong academic record.
- Applicants must be registered in a Ph.D. program at a university in Egypt.
- Applicants must find an American professor in the U.S. who is willing to host him/her and co-supervise his/her Ph.D. program for one academic year. The U.S. co-supervisor must be familiar with the applicant's field of study and Ph.D. proposal, as well as have the willingness to supervise the applicant's research in the U.S.
- Applicants must submit an invitation letter from one U.S. co-supervisor inviting the applicant to spend up to one year at the U.S. university to conduct his/her Ph.D. research and confirming that the research will be under the supervision of the identified U.S. co-supervisor. The letter must also include an evaluation of the applicant's thesis proposal, as well as describe the facilities that will be available to the applicant in the U.S. for conducting his/her research.
- Applicants must submit a letter of support from the Egyptian home institution Ph.D. supervisor which includes an evaluation of the applicant's thesis proposal and approval for the applicant to travel to the U.S. to conduct research and collect data for the Ph.D. degree under the supervision of the U.S. co-supervisor.
- Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants must successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).

The program provides fully funded grants for students registered in Ph.D. programs at universities in Egypt to collect data and/or conduct research for 6 to 9 months in the U.S.

All fields are eligible.

### Eligibility Criteria:

- Egyptian citizenship. U.S. citizens and green card holders and applicants are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants must reside in Egypt starting from the application process and throughout the selection, placement and pre-departure processes.
- Master's degree. Strong academic record.
- Applicants must be registered in a Ph.D. program at a university in Egypt.
- Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants must successfully complete all the steps of the application, assessment, and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).

- Five years of full-time professional experience. Demonstrated leadership qualities and a record of public service.
- Proof of English Language proficiency. Minimum TOEFL ITP (450), TOEFL iBT (45), IELTS (5.0), Duolingo (60), or an English Proficiency Test from Egyptian Universities (450).
- Limited prior experience in the U.S.
- Qualified women are encouraged to apply.
- Individuals with disabilities are encouraged to apply.
- Applicants have to successfully complete all the steps of the assessment and selection process and successfully finalize all required procedures.
- **Note:**
  - Academics and faculty members must have professional experience in the field of application, in addition to their teaching responsibilities, in order to be eligible for the program.
  - Academics with administrative or management responsibilities are eligible to apply for the fields of: Higher Education Administration; and Education Administration, Planning, and Policy.
  - Academics with no administrative or management responsibilities, or who do not have professional experience within their field of specialization, are ineligible (except in the fields of: Teaching English as a Foreign Language; and Substance Abuse Education, Prevention, and Treatment).
- The following persons and their immediate family members (i.e. spouses and children) are ineligible to apply during and for a period ending one year following the termination of such employment: employees of the U.S. Department of State; local employees of the U.S. missions abroad who work for the U.S. Department of State and/or the U.S. Agency for International Development (USAID); employees at organizations implementing exchange programs for the Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs at the Department of State; as well as Board Members or staff of a Fulbright Commission or their families (up to fourth kin).

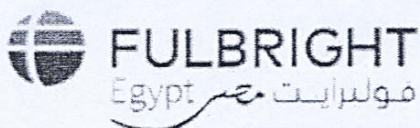

## FULBRIGHT SPECIALIST PROGRAM

### PROGRAM GOAL:

The Fulbright Specialist Program promotes linkages between U.S. academics and professionals, and their counterparts at Egyptian institutions. The program is designed to award grants to qualified U.S. faculty and professionals to engage in short-term collaborative 2- to 6-week projects at universities and other institutions in Egypt. Project activities focus on the developmental needs of institutions. Personal research is not funded by the Specialist program.

Fulbright Specialist projects provide U.S. faculty and professionals with opportunities to collaborate with their Egyptian professional counterparts on curriculum and faculty development, institutional planning, and a variety of other activities in agriculture, engineering, humanities, mathematics, science and technology, and the social sciences.

### PROJECT ACTIVITIES MAY INCLUDE:

- Conducting needs assessments, institutional or programmatic research
- Taking part in specialized academic programs and conferences
- Consulting with administrators and instructors of post-secondary institutions on faculty development
- Presenting lectures at graduate and undergraduate levels
- Participating in or leading seminars or workshops at Egyptian institutions
- Developing and/or assessing academic curricula or educational materials
- Conducting teacher-training programs at the tertiary levels

### APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS AND PROCEDURES:

- The requested American Scholar must be registered in an online roster maintained by World Learning, the program's implementing partner. U.S. faculty and professionals may apply to the roster by visiting: <https://fulbrightspecialist.worldlearning.org/>. Roster candidates are peer-reviewed and approved by the J. William Fulbright Foreign Scholarship Board.
- The Specialist must be a U.S. citizen resident in the United States at the time that the grant is approved.
- Alumni of other programs, including the Fulbright Program, may apply. Preference is generally given to candidates with the most relevant professional experience.
- Egyptian institutions wishing to host a Specialist must submit a project proposal via World Learning's online portal here: <https://worldlearning-community.force.com/FSPHost> at least three months prior to the requested arrival date of the scholar. An institution may submit:
  - A Named Request: the institution identifies the scholar whom it would like to host.
  - An Unnamed Request: the institution identifies the field of specialization in which it would like to host a Specialist and describes the activities to be pursued.

### GRANT PROVISIONS:

- International travel and honorarium are provided by the U.S. Department of State.
- Lodging, meals, and local transportation are provided by the host institution.
